	FOCUS - Money and subtraction strategies
	ACTIVITY: TRY THIS
<p>Set up a pretend store in your kitchen and start labeling things a pretend cost, like three cents for spaghetti or six cents for a can of soup. Provide your child with pennies and nickels and explain that five pennies can be exchanged for one nickel. You can try higher denominations with older children. Let your child go "shopping" and try to pay you correctly for each item.</p>

	FOCUS - Exploring light and dark
	ACTIVITY: TRY THIS
<p>You can use a flashlight to observe how light interacts with a variety of everyday materials. Collect objects like wooden blocks, small toy cars and figures, clear plastic cups, straws, pieces of waxed paper, aluminum foil and clear plastic wrap. Dim the lights and start exploring! Talk about what you observe as you shine the light on different materials. Which materials block the light and create shadows? Which ones create reflections? Which ones let all of the light or some of the light pass through? Encourage your child to draw and write about his/her observations.</p>

	FOCUS - Storytelling; sharing stories with others
	ACTIVITY: TRY THIS
<p>Play "Story Stick"—a fun, oral storytelling game you can play together as a family. Gather in a circle and whoever holds the "story stick" (you can use a stick or a ball, stuffed animal, etc.) tells a part of the story that everyone in circle will add onto when it's their turn. Before starting, it's helpful if an adult or an older child provide a setting, theme, or conflict for the experience. If there are reluctant storytellers, encourage their thinking with questions such as "What did you see?" or "And then what happened?" It's ok if the story is silly or nonsensical, that's part of the fun!</p>

	ACTIVITY: TRY THIS
<p>Help children draw the connection between their kind, cooperative behavior and friendship. This might sound like, "I noticed that you sat by your sister when she was feeling upset. You are a good friend," or "Let's help clean up before we have dinner. Cleaning up is a great way to be a friend."</p>

<p>Challenge your child to imagine he or she is different characters and act the part: Walk and talk like a pirate. Act confident like a superhero! Babble and crawl like a baby. Be a butterfly! Act like a favorite storybook character. Talk about how your child uses their body and voice to become that character.</p>
