

As is somewhat typical for December, we don't have a lot of new programming. There are a number of Christmas specials scattered throughout the schedule. Some are new or annual updates, and some are perennial favorites. There are too many to list, but I'll draw attention to one from our colleagues



at WHYY in Philadelphia, **Westminster Choir College presents An Evening of Readings and Carols**.

The program features more than 400 musicians in five different choirs. Together with a number of secular readings, the evening brings beauty and comfort to you at this special time of year. Catch this WHYY special on December 21 or Christmas Eve at 9pm.

Looking ahead to January 7, we have a double bill of season four premieres from two popular **MASTERPIECE** titles.

First up, at 8pm, is the British crime drama, **Miss Scarlet and The Duke** followed by the ever popular drama, **All Creatures Great and Small** at 9pm.

It's a solid winter **MASTERPIECE** line-up

on WITF TV and the PBS app. You can revisit both series now on WITF Passport, or catch reruns of season 3 episodes from both series on Saturday and Sunday nights throughout December on WITF TV.

One final note is to look forward to a new season of *Finding Your Roots*. The personal history series from Henry Louis Gates, Jr. returns to its regular Tuesday slot beginning in January with new episodes stretching all the way out to April.

We'll have some exciting news to share about this series next month. Stay tuned!






