This spring has been a parade of new, short drama series from **MASTERPIECE**. May includes another new series, **MaryLand**. The three-part drama follows two estranged sisters who reunite to unearth the truth about their mother's sudden death and her double life on the Isle of Man. Watch as the two sisters work out a string of family secrets on Sundays at 9pm, beginning May 5.

MaryLand is also available to stream on the PBS App with WITF Passport, along with several other recent **MASTERPIECE** titles, such as **Mr Bates vs The Post Office**, **Nolly**, and **All Creatures Great and Small**.

Major League Baseball's 2024 season is well underway and what better time than now to replay one of Ken Burns' documentaries, *Jackie Robinson*. In this two-part series, we see how Robinson rose from humble origins to integrate Major League Baseball, performed brilliantly despite the threats and abuse he faced on and off the field and, in the process, challenged the prejudiced notions of what a Black man can achieve. Catch the two-part series, May 9 and May 16, at 9pm.

Great Performances brings you another experience of the Shakespearean classic **Hamlet**, presented by The Public Theater's Free Shakespeare in the Park at The Delacorte Theater in Central Park in New York City. The performance features Tony Award nominee Ato Blankson-Wood in the title role and Solea Pfeiffer as Ophelia.

Set in a desolate post-George Floyd world, this contemporary production is a present-day take on the Bard's tale of family and betrayal. Catch *Hamlet* on WITF TV Friday, May 10 at 9pm.

We wish Bob Dylan a happy birthday with a



replay of the *American Masters* two-part episode about him over two Thursday nights, on May 23 and May 30 at 9pm. The production focuses on the singer-songwriter's life and music, from his explosive arrival on the downtown New York City scene in 1961 — with a raspy voice, pounding guitar, and stunning lyrics — through his near-fatal motorcycle accident near Woodstock in 1966.

No one changed the landscape of contemporary music more profoundly. Private, almost reclusive, Dylan agreed to appear in his own story. Directed by Martin Scorsese, this biography from **American Masters** includes previously never-before-seen footage from Dylan's childhood, the road, and backstage, as well as interviews conducted over five years with other seminal figures from those times.

We wrap up May with the annual **National Memorial Day Concert** on Sunday, May 26 at 8pm. Now in its 35th year, America's national night of remembrance returns live from the

west lawn of the U.S. Capitol.

This year's rendition features worldrenowned artists with the National Symphony Orchestra for a deeply moving annual event unlike anything else, bringing us together as one family of Americans to honor the service of generations of our men and women in uniform.

Thanks for taking the time to watch WITF. I've had a chance to meet many of you through several WITF events, including preview screenings of *All Creatures Great and Small* in January, *Gospel* in February, and *Finding Your Roots* in April. It's always a privilege that you let us into your living rooms every day to provide you with enriching and entertaining programming.



The prime minister is forced to confront who he is and what he is willing to sacrifice to remain in power.


