I hope you enjoyed the reimagining of the Forsythe saga with *The Forsytes on MASTERPIECE*, which concluded last month. Good news if you enjoyed it — another season just completed taping for release next year. I'm also hearing word the series has already been renewed for a third season. Speaking of renewals, *All Creatures Great and Small* wrapped up the 6th season earlier this year, and seasons seven and eight are already in the pipeline! *Miss Scarlet* is also coming back for a 7th season, however this will be the final season for Eliza's crime solving in Victorian London.

Just around the bend is *Grantchester*. The 11th and final season of this series begins on June 14. I'm sad to see the show depart our schedules, but it has been a fantastic run for the past 11 years on WITF. The show has been a delight over the summers for a little more than a decade, beginning with James Norton as Sidney Chambers, followed by Tom Brittney and now Rishi Nair. All 10 current seasons are available to watch on-demand through the PBS app for **WITF Passport** subscribers. This month we're wrapping up our replay of season one of *Turn: Washington's Spies*. This series is a character-driven drama set during the Revolutionary War, taking us behind the battlefield to a shadow war fought by everyday heroes who vowed to keep their heroics a secret.
